- New Breaking Bread Missalette/Hymnal will arrive by Advent, if approved by the finance councils.

d. Baccalaureate Mass

- One Mass for graduates from all four parishes. All parishioners and guests are welcome at the Mass being held at St. Kathryn's Ogilvie on May 19 at 12:00 noon. A Banquet will follow for graduate, graduate's parents, and graduate's siblings.
- All students to present with a cap and gown for Mass, cap would not be worn during Mass.

Other discussion topics:

- Father questioned advertisement in local papers, i.e. Gateway to the North, if we are getting a return on investment, many people using cell phones to locate parishes with travel.
- Tara would like to have a list of activities or fundraisers that our parishes "normally do" each year/season. This would prevent her from doubling up on activities or doing similar ones for the youth and young adult groups.
