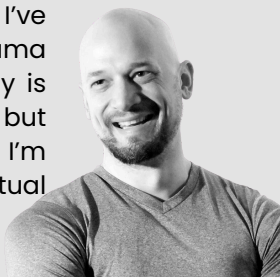

There is so much that can be said about Pier Giorgio Frassati and the impact he had in his own lifetime, as well as the relevance of his story today. As the playwright, I'm inclined to let the play speak for itself, but I will say this: I've attempted to write more of a spiritual biographical drama than a strictly historical biographical drama. The play is deeply rooted in historical people, places and events, but beyond simply telling a compelling historical story, I'm ultimately trying to tell an even more compelling spiritual story. – Jeremy D. A September 28, 2021, article written about the Frassati play in The Catholic Spirit, has this to share about the life of Pier Giorgio Frassati: "Pier Giorgio Frassati was an avid mountaineer, engineering student and political activist in Turin, Italy. He was also deeply devoted to the poor, his family and the Eucharist. When he died of polio in 1925 at age 24, droves of mourners lined the streets outside his funeral to pay respects. According to biographies, the Frassatis – an influential Italian family – were shocked to know their son had been so close to orphans, the sick and people in poverty. The poor were equally surprised to find that their friend was from such a prominent family."
