- ▶ St. Mary's, Milaca and St. Louis Bertrand, Foreston clustered previously, Crosier Priest

▶ Total members of ACC - 1,162 Catholics

- ▶ St. Louis Bertrand, Foreston - 149 Families, 216 Members
 - ▶ St. Mary's, Milaca - 182 Families, 420 Members
 - ▶ St. Kathryn's, Ogilvie - 69 Families, 145 Members
 - ▶ St. Mary's, Mora - 182 Families, 381 Members
- ▶ St. John's Area School in Foley - Pre-K through 6th grade
- ▶ St. Louis Bertrand is a contributing member



Strengths and Areas of Pride

Our Biggest Struggle

- ▶ Communication challenges
 - ▶ Planning council
 - ▶ ACC council
 - ▶ Dissolving individual parish councils
- ▶ Linear distance between parishes
 - ▶ Limits focus and availability of pastor to serve 4 parishes
 - ▶ Limits parishioner's ability to join ACC events
- ▶ Differing perspectives on key issues
 - ▶ History of parishes
 - ▶ Different communities
 - ▶ Different cultures of each parish
 - ▶ Mass attendance & Mass times



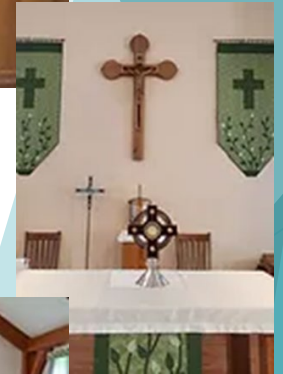
How We Are Listening to the People in Our ACC
